<p>BE CREATIVE!</p> <p>Write a rap, song, story, poem, or letter to a friend using all your spelling words.</p>	<p>GET MOVING!</p> <p>Do jumping jacks, bounce a ball, or jump rope as you spell each of your spelling words.</p>	<p>SWITCH HANDS!</p> <p>If you are right-handed, write all your words with your left hand, or vice versa.</p>	<p>WRITE 5 TIMES!</p> <p>Write or type each of your spelling words 5 times using different colors for each letter.</p>
<p>WORD SCRAMBLE!</p> <p>Ask another person to write your spelling words, but with all the letters scrambled. Try to unscramble them.</p>	<p>CUT AND PASTE!</p> <p>Find your words, or create your words using letters from a newspaper or magazine. Cut and glue them to a piece of paper.</p>	<p>SPELLING PYRAMIDS!</p> <p>Write the first letter on the first line. Write the first and second letter on the second line and so on...</p> <p>c ca cat</p>	<p>FUNNY SENTENCES!</p> <p>Write sentences to make someone laugh using at least one spelling word in each.</p>
<p>ABC ORDER!</p> <p>Write your words in ABC order.</p>	<p>RAINBOW WORDS!</p> <p>Write your spelling words using more than one colored pencil, crayon, or marker at the same time.</p>	<p>FUN FONTS!</p> <p>Use your computer to type your words using different fonts to make it look really cool!</p>	<p>FANCY FINGERS!</p> <p>Write each spelling word in your fanciest handwriting. You can use bubble words, dotted words, curly words, or anything else!</p>
<p>CONCENTRATION!</p> <p>Cut index cards or paper into 20 squares. Write each of your ten spelling words twice—one word per card. Lay out the cards face down and try to match spelling words.</p>	<p>FRIENDLY WORDS!</p> <p>Try to connect all your spelling words by connecting each one with letters they have in common, like Scrabble.</p> <p>Example:</p> <p>c boat t</p>	<p>AIR WORDS!</p> <p>Use your finger to write your words in the air. Have an adult do the same. See if you can figure out each other's words.</p>	<p>3D WORDS!</p> <p>Use play dough, blocks, string, or any other 3D object to build each of your spelling words.</p>
